For a number of years Brent has been an influential thought leader in the field of protected information-sharing. He co-founded the Utah Electronic Law and Commerce Partnership and helped found LegalXML, now part of OASIS. Brent was appointed by then-Utah Governor Michael Leavitt as an initial member of the Utah Electronic Commerce Council and was later appointed to serve as the Co-Chair of the Web Services Group for the Utah Technology Alliance (UTA). He has one patent issued with several others pending. For twelve years, Brent was a practicing attorney in Washington, DC at the U.S. Department of Commerce, the U.S. Court of Claims, and with Morgan, Lewis & Bockius, one of the largest law firms in the world. He holds a B.S. in Economics from Utah State University and a J.D. from Brigham Young University.
